

ASIAN MICRO IMPORTS COMPRESSED NATURAL GAS (CNG) ENGINES, CNG MINI BUSES, CNG TRUCKS, & CNG PRIME MOVERS/TRACTOR HEADS INTO THAILAND

Asian Micro Holdings Limited (AMH) through one of its subsidiaries, AM NGV (S) Pte. Ltd., has begun importing commercial Natural Gas Vehicles (NGVs) like CNG trucks, CNG buses, and heavy duty CNG prime movers into Thailand.

S.O. NGV. (Thailand) Co., Ltd (“SO NGV Thai”), another subsidiary of AMH, shall be handling the after-sales services in Thailand for these NGVs. AM NGV has also imported CNG Engines into Thailand to provide additional sales revenue for the Company and also to enable SO NGV Thai to embark on re-powering of diesel vehicles, i.e., to replace their old diesel engines with new CNG engines.

AM NGV will also commence direct import of CNG gas cylinders and conversion kits required for vehicle conversion and for distribution in the region.

In summary, Asian Micro will grow NGV business in Thailand via:

1. NGV conversion business;
2. Trading of CNG gas cylinders and conversion kits;
3. Import and sales of NGVs; and,
4. After-sales services of NGVs and NGV engines.

The first shipment of NGV engines arrived in Thailand while the first NGV mini bus from Dongfeng Shiyan Co., Ltd has just arrived in Thailand.

Subsequently two units of 300 horse power NGV prime movers are due to arrive in Thailand in November 2007.

Asian Micro's NGV Dongfeng prime mover will be available in the range of 280hp, 300hp, 320hp, 340/350hp and 375hp and will be expected to provide huge fuel saving for potential owners.

Thailand Conversion Centres' update

The second Conversion Centre in Korat can be ready by mid September 2007, while the third conversion centre in Changmai can be ready at the end of September 2007.

Our fourth conversion centers will be located at Khon Kaen which is Northern Eastern towards Laos border, and the fifth conversion centre will be located at Surat Thani towards the South instead of earlier planned location at Udon Thani.

New Conversion Centre in Singapore

Asian Micro shall be setting up its first NGV conversion centre [S.O. NGV (S) Pte Ltd] in Singapore before November 2007.

However, it should be noted that NGV conversion will be more widely received in countries like Thailand, where CNG is more readily available, than in Singapore.
